

## **Lucky Dip Game:**

The element of surprise makes this game an attraction at any party. Instead of dipping into a box of goodies and digging something out, each guest selects one of the dangling labels, then fishes out the gift on the other end of the string. The design of the tags can vary according to the theme of the party. I chose St. Patrick's Day for March.

### **You need:**

A large cardboard box

scissors

colored poster board

markers or crayons

tissue paper

gifts that go with your party theme

string or narrow ribbon.

Cover the box in paper or shapes to make it fun.

Make poster board shapes of anything from candy, balls, flowers, or whatever fits your theme.

**In my case I made shamrocks, leprechaun hats, gold coins etc.** You will need (2) sizes of each shape, a larger one to attach to the gift and a smaller one to tie to the other end of the string.

Cut out the tags and color them. Make a small hole in each tag to run the string.

Thread a piece of string through the hole in the large tag and know the end. Thread the opposite end through the matching small tag, then knot that end. **Make sure the string is long enough to dangle over the outside of your box.**

Tie the string near each large tag around a gift.

Put the gifts in the box with their small tags dangling around the sides. Pack the box with crumpled tissue paper to hide the gifts.

To make this more interesting I will ask each resident a question about St. Patricks' Day. If he/she answered correctly, they will be able to go up to the box and pick a tag. I bought the gifts from the Dollar Tree so they were in-expensive and went with my theme. **Beads, window clings, buttons etc.**
