Hi Kathi: We just heard a simple Yahtzee (sp- I think it is correct) game at NAAP conference. Thanks goes to Chris Bobos if you use the idea.

Yahtzee for everyone:

Conventional game using dice and score card available.

Have your group shake the dice taking turns. On the first round, count the 1s. Second round, count the 2s. Third round, count the 3s; fourth, count the 4s; fifth, count 5s and on the sixth, count the 6s. The one with the highest score wins. No need to confuse everyone with the conventional game and residents are able to count the numbers themselves. Often others help with the counting.

Use it if you need to, no problem if you get tons of others. Just nice for a middle functioning group and it works well. I have been using it. Please doctor it up if you need. djc
